More than 2,500 U.S. general hospitals were assigned scores in October 2015, with only 773 hospitals receiving an A grade. In addition to Swedish Covenant Hospital, the other Chicago hospitals to earn eight consecutive A grades include University of Medicine, Chicago Illinois Masonic and Rush University Medical Center.

The Hospital Safety Score makes its data analysis and methodology available to the public on its website. This year, patients can also review their hospital's past safety performance alongside its current grade on the Hospital Safety Score site, allowing them to determine which local hospitals have the best track record in patient safety and which have demonstrated consistent improvement.
